## **Scott Mitnick Named City Manager**

THOUSAND OAKS, CA – Thousand Oaks City Council appointed Interim City Manager Scott Mitnick to the job permanently at the November 15, 2005 Council meeting.

Mitnick's local government career has spanned more than 17 years involving four cities in different regions of California. For the past six months, he has served as Interim City Manager. He previously served as Assistant City Manager and has been with the City of Thousand Oaks for nearly six years.

"In the past several months, Scott has worked extremely hard and has earned the respect of City staff. He is really deserving of this appointment and staff looks forward to working with him and Council to take the City to the next level," said Don Nelson, Acting Assistant City Manager.

Mitnick began his career with the City of Brea as a Budget Analyst. He then spent seven years with the City of Burbank. While at Burbank, he worked as a Financial Analyst, Project Manager, Assistant to the City Manager, and Budget Officer.

From Burbank, Mitnick moved to the Northern Sacramento Valley to spend three years with the City of Yuba City as Administrative Services Director. This was a Department Head level position in which he functioned as both Assistant City Manager and Finance Director. In December 1999, he joined the City of Thousand Oaks.
